

## **AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION**

between the

**UNIVERSITY OF CYPRUS**

and the

**UNIVERSITY OF LISBON**

The purpose of this agreement is to promote co-operation in the fields of teaching and research between the **UNIVERSITY OF CYPRUS** and the **UNIVERSITY OF LISBON**.

Both institutions will make every reasonable effort to encourage direct contact and research co-operation between their respective faculty members and students. Both institutions agree on the following general forms of co-operation:

- (i) Joint research activities
- (ii) Exchange of academic materials and academic publications and information
- (iii) Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures and discussions
- (iv) Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study, research and clinical training
- (v) Co-organisation of and participation in lectures, seminars and conferences
- (vi) Co-operation in administrative issues

The themes of joint activities, the conditions for utilising the results achieved and the arrangements of specific visits, exchanges and other forms of co-operation will appear as separate Addenda to the present agreement, and will be negotiated for each specific case by the interested parties.

Collaboration will include the areas of the exchanging of experience in theoretical issues and practical methods of attracting students in the field of European Studies, as well as Research and innovation activities of common interest covering a range of specializations in the areas of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT) with relevance to the monitoring, control, management and security of critical infrastructures and related to transportation systems, electric power systems, water distribution networks, telecommunication networks and security. Any other areas of collaboration are not to be excluded.

It is understood that all financial arrangements between the two institutions would be negotiated individually for each Addenda to this Agreement.

It is also understood that the implementation of this Agreement will commence upon its signing by both parties, and that it will be valid for five years, subject to revision or modification by mutual consent. The possibility and terms of renewal of their agreement will be discussed by the representatives of both institutions within six months prior to its termination.
